**Course objective:** An overview on the evolution of the French literature from the perspective of the cultural life and the dynamics of ideas; a systematic approach of literature from its three different perspectives: language, ideology, creativity.

**Course contents:** Introduction to issues related to author's objectivity and involvement; Mihail Bahtin and «dialogism»; Emile Benveniste – enunciation between «discourse» and «history»; Wayne C. Booth and «the involved author»; Gérard Genette – beyond the narrator; Dorrit Cohn: the narrator and the character, between «consonance» and «dissonance»; Philippe Lejeune, autobiography, from likeness to truth.
