Obiectivul cursului: Strengthen students' previously acquired grammatical and linguistic knowledge through the analysis of the key-problems in the field. These differentiations include: (i) the meaning and referent, (ii) denotation and connotation (iii) hyponymy, synonymy and antonymy (iv) inference, implication and presupposition (v) statement, sentence and enunciation.

Course contents: Practice the revised notions through linguistic analyses of various texts, apply the syntactic, semantic and pragmatic knowledge to text analyses or translations, and analyze texts from the grammatical and linguistic viewpoints.
