**Course objective**: The course represents a general introduction to the theory and history of interpretation and comprehension, with a special focus on the hermeneutics of German schools of the 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. The course treats, among others, authors belonging to the Romantic German culture (F. E. D. Schleiermacher, Friedrich Schlegel), as well as authors from the 20<sup>th</sup> century, such as Gadamer and Ricoeur.

**Course contents**: Definition and meanings of the concept of hermeneutics, stages of the history of hermeneutics, representatives, fields, types of interpretation, hermeneutical concepts (text, method, hermeneutical circle, hermeneutical difference, etc)
