



Scientific excellence in Horizon 2020 projects: Gender in project's life cycle

Training session - 9 December, 2014

At the solicitation of the academic and research staff in our university, the UAIC-FP7 STAGES project in cooperation with the Centre for Gender Equality in Science organizes on the 9 December a one day training on "Scientific excellence in Horizon 2020 projects: gender in project's life cycle".

The training is delivered by an European expert on Horizon 2020 applications (Mrs. Catarina Arnaut, from Belgium) and will be held in the Senate Room, from 9:00 to 17:30 (please, see below the programme). The training will be divided in two sessions:

- The <u>morning session</u> comprises an overall introduction into gender and research and show how gender is interwoven with all aspects of research. It will then examine in pragmatic terms how a gender dimension of research content contributes to excellence in research. Here we zoom in into Horizon 2020.
- During the <u>afternoon session</u>, case studies are analyzed based on concrete examples drawn from two specific research fields: <u>nanosciences and biotechnology</u> and <u>inclusive</u>, <u>innovative</u> and <u>reflective societies</u>.
