



Accommodation fee: approx. 130 euros/month







# **IMPORTANT!**

You are advised to write to your EEA academic coordinator immediately after you arrive.

- An initial meeting will be established, during which you will receive guidance on academic issues such as: course selection, professors, lecture halls, timetables etc.
- **❖** You will also decide if you need to make any CHANGES to the initial Learning Agreement (within the first 2/3 weeks).

# **REGISTRATION AT THE FACULTY**

- ❖ During the first week after your arrival, you will have to visit the Secretariat of your host Faculty, in order to temporarily enroll as one of the students of our University. For this mandatory step, you will need:
  - ✓ Your passport/national identity card (both in original and copy);
  - ✓ A copy of your Learning Agreement, signed by the EEA academic coordinators of both your home and host university;
  - ✓ A copy of the Transcript of Records issued by your home university;
  - √ 2 passport-sized photos
- ❖ Throughout the entire duration of your EEA study mobility, you will have the same rights and obligations as the degree-seeking full-time students of *Alexandru Ioan Cuza* University of Iaşi.

## **AFTER REGISTERING, YOU WILL RECEIVE:**

- ✓ a student ID card (carnet de student) that is valid only for your EEA study period. The student card may be required in the University or in any other institution where student identity needs to be proven. You may use your student card during the session of exams, when each professor will write down, under signature, the grade you obtained in his/her exam.
- ✓ a <u>public transport permit</u> (legitimație de transport) that you can use when you buy tickets for buses and trams. By showing your student travel card you may benefit from a 50% discount.

# PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- You need S.C.T.P. tickets.
- You can buy the tickets from the S.C.T.P. booth (these can be found in almost every bus/tram station)
- YOU MUST BUY THE TICKETS FROM THE BOOTH PRIOR TO GETTING ON THE TRAM/BUS, **YOU CANNOT BUY THEM FROM INSIDE!**



## With student discount

- 1 trip ticket = 1,25 RON
- **2** trips = **2**,**5** RON
- a set of 20 tickets (1 trip each) = 20 RON

An iconic monument, the *Palace of Culture lasi* was inaugurated in 1925. It has no less than 299 rooms hosting four museums, historical artefacts, art galleries and a large public library, 92 windows in the front part of the building and another 36 inside the building. The Palace has become a <u>symbol of the city and its cultural scene</u>. The palace is currently listed in the National Register of Historic Monuments.

# ... You may want visit the most important monuments of art in lasi, as well as the most important religious sites. lasi is extremely rich in religious monuments of all ages, from the Middle Ages (the 'embroidered' <u>Church of the Three Hierarchs</u>) to the modern times (<u>the Metropolitan Church</u>).

You may also want to visit the beautiful sites around the city (CIRIC lake and forest; BIRNOVA, BUCIUM and POIENI forests).

But most of all, make sure to take a trip to the famous chain of **monasteries in Northern Moldavia**. Most of them are painted monasteries dating back to the 15th – 16th centuries. To give just a few examples:

- ✓ the Monastery of VORONET is unique in the world due to the mysterious origin of its deepblue colour and to the painting of the "Last Judgment" on its western exterior wall;
- ✓ the Monastery of PUTNA has a powerful symbolical meaning for the Romanian people because it was built by the most famous Moldavian ruler, Stefan cel Mare (Stephen the Great), whose grave is also at Putna;
- ✓ the Monasteries of SUCEVITA, MOLDOVITA, DRAGOMIRNA, ARBORE, BISTRITA, AGAPIA, VARATEC and many others are all beautifully-painted unique monuments of art and religion.
