

- ▶ SHARE-ERIC is a research infrastructure for studying the effects of health, social, economic and environmental policies over the life-course of European citizens and beyond.
 - ▶ SHARE is the largest pan-European social science panel study providing internationally comparable longitudinal micro data which allow insights in the fields of public health and socio-economic living conditions of European individuals.
- ▶ Started in 2004; 8 completed waves; over 530,000 in-depth face-to-face interviews (CAPI); more than 140,000 respondents.
- ▶ Target population: people aged 50 or older from 28 European countries and Israel.
 - ▶ In Romania: since 2017 (Wave 7) (1500 interviews).
 - ▶ Wave 9: face-to-face interviewing started fall 2021.
- ▶ During COVID-19
 - ▶ First SHARE Corona Survey (CATI) in June/July 2020
 - ▶ Second SHARE Corona Survey (CATI) in May/June 2021
