ACCOMMODATION

Our University can accommodate approximately 6000 students in its 16 student dormitories, at very reasonable prices.

FOOD FACILITIES

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

By upholding the core academic values which stood at its foundation in 1860 and by prevailing over the difficulties encountered throughout half a century of restrictions which hindered the academic spirit, after 1990, Alexandru Ioan Cuza University (UAIC) continued to develop its cooperation in education and scientific research on a worldwide scale. The joint project exchanges and other academic events carried out in partnership with prestigious HEIs from around the world have not only brought more diversity and vibrancy to the academic life, but also added great value to the quality of teaching, and generally enhanced both the scientific findings and the university's community engagement.

Some of the most noteworthy and long-lasting exchanges have been taking place between UAIC and University of Freiburg, University of Konstanz and University of Lille.

From among the most proactive partnerships of UAIC, a mention must be



made of the collaboration with the University of Jena, Germany (the oldest cooperation agreement), with the University of Poitiers, France, the University of Groningen, the Netherlands, as well as with the University of Granada, Spain.

Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iași constantly implements a steadfast internationalization strategy and is a member of many prestigious and prominent EU academic consortia, like the Utrecht Network, the Coimbra Group, the European University Association and Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie.



STUDY AT UAIC



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

EU and non-EU citizens are welcome to register for admission, provided that they hold a high-school graduation diploma, equivalent to the Romanian Bacalaureate.

REASONABLY PRICED TUITION FEES

Amounts for non-EU students:
2000 - 2500 Euro/year (Bachelor studies)
2200 - 2700 Euro/year (for Master studies)
3000 - 3600 Euro/year (PhD studies)

Romanian and EU citizens may study either for free or at a maximum cost of 950 euro/year, depending exclusively on their academic records.

Study programs in English and French are available at both undergraduate and graduate level.
