Call for applications

The "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iasi announces the organization of a competition for the filling of the following 4 research vacancies, for a fixed term (for the duration of the project), part-time, 2 hours/day (each post) within the research project entitled "Spatial Analysis of Growth, Environment and Sustainable Well-being", acronym SAGES, project code CF 20/27.07.2023, contract no. MCID - DGGCPNRR 760275/26.03.2024, funded by the National Recovery and Resilience Plan Call no. PNRR-III-C9-2023 - I8_round 2, carried out within the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iasi.

SAGES is a multidisciplinary project seeking to contribute to an advanced and internationally oriented profile of Romanian researchers in the field of the analytics of wellbeing and happiness in a spatial context. The project has a few part-time vacancies.

We are looking for young enthusiastic researchers with strong analytical - preferably quantitative - skills, including digital approaches to data handling. The work takes place in an international research environment. More information can be found on the project website https://sages.uaic.ro. In your application letter your profile, motivation and expected contribution to the project has to be highlighted.

<u>4 vacancies Post-doctoral researcher</u> with the following part-time <u>positions</u>:

- 1. 4 positions Post-doctoral researcher, basic field Social Sciences 2 hours/day;
- 1. The positions were approved by the Rector of the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iasi, following the Executive Board of the Board of Administration no. 1P of 07.02.2025.
- 2. The competition to fill the research vacancies mentioned above, for a fixed term (for the duration of the project), part-time, 2 hours/day, will be conducted in compliance with the provisions of the Methodology of the competition for the filling of teaching and research positions at the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iasi, the provisions of Law no. 199/2023 on higher education, the provisions of Law 319/2003 on the Statute of Research and Development Staff, the Decision no. 583/2015 for the approval of the National Plan for Research and Development and Innovation for the period 2015-2020 (PNCDI III), with subsequent additions and amendments and will follow the schedule posted on the university website: www.uaic.ro, section "Angajari".
- 3. The competition timetable is presented in the "Competition timetable for the above-mentioned research posts, fixed-term (during the project period), part-time, 2 hours/day, within the research project entitled "Spatial Analysis of Growth, Environment and Sustainable Well-being", acronym SAGES, project code CF 20/27.07.2023, contract no. MCID DGGCPNRR 760275/26.03.2024, funded by the National Recovery and Resilience Plan Call no. PNRR-III-C9-2023 I8_round 2, carried out within the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iaşi, published www.uaic.ro, section "Angajari".
- 4. The content of the application files, according to the Methodology of the competition, for the filling of teaching and research positions at the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iasi, will consist of:
 - a) **application form**, in accordance with *Annex 4*, signed by the candidate, accompanied by a declaration on his/her own responsibility, drawn up in handwriting by the candidate when submitting the application, based on a model provided or in accordance with the model posted on www.uaic.ro section 'Recruitment'- LEGISLATION and DOCUMENTS Forms;

- b) a proposal for the development of the applicant's academic career in terms of scientific research activities within the project (https://sages.uaic.ro/); the proposal must include a motivation letter of maximum 1000 words (including spaces); the proposal is written by the applicant and is one of the main criteria for the selection of the candidates (in Romanian and in English);
- c) curriculum vitae in printed and electronic format (Europass model) (in Romanian and English);
- d) list of papers in printed and electronic format (in Romanian and English);
- e) the University's minimum standards by subject area, in accordance with the model in Annex 2c, for fixed-term research posts within the University's faculties. The University's standards shall be at least equal to the national minimum standards approved under Art. 156 para. (1) letter a) and para. (2) of the Law on Higher Education No. 199/2023, as amended. The check sheets in Annex 2c are completed and signed by the candidate with the following specific requirements:
 - For *Post-doctoral Researcher* positions:
 - a doctoral degree in Social Sciences;
 - a maximum of 8 years from the date on which the diploma was awarded at the time of the competition.
- f) documents relating to the possession of a doctor's degree in the field of the post or in related fields in the case of interdisciplinary posts: the original copy of the doctor's degree and, if the original doctor's degree is not recognized in Romania, the original copy of the certificate of its recognition or equivalence;
- g) the abstract of the doctoral thesis in Romanian and in an international language, maximum one page for each language;
- h) **declaration on the candidate's own responsibility**, according to *Annex 5*, in which he/she indicates the situations of incompatibility provided by the Law on higher education no. 199/2023, with subsequent amendments and additions, in which he/she would be in if he/she wins the competition or the absence of such situations of incompatibility;
- i) **copies of other diplomas** certifying the candidate's studies (bachelor's, master's, postgraduate diplomas, accompanied by transcripts/supplements to the diploma);
- j) a copy of your identity card or, if you do not have an identity card, a copy of your passport or other identity document issued for an equivalent purpose;
- k) copies of the documents proving the change of name, where the candidate has changed his/her name, i.e. marriage certificate or proof of change of name;
- l) a maximum of 10 publications, patents or other works in electronic format, selected by the candidate and considered most relevant to his/her professional achievements;
- m) criminal record certificate;
- n) certificate of behavioral integrity;
- o) **Medical certificate** (in original) attesting that you are in good health, issued no more than 6 months before the competition by your family doctor or by the relevant health authorities.
- p) medical certificate, according to the model Order 4060/2024-ANNEX no. 1 MEDICAL CERTIFICATE OCCUPATIONAL MEDICINE in order to apply for the competition;
- q) **Psychiatric opinion** in order to apply for the competition for a teaching or auxiliary teaching post in higher education, issued according to the model ORDIN 4060/2024-Appendix no. 2 (original);
- r) statement on the processing of personal data Annex 6 in accordance with the provisions on the protection of personal data under Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation);
- (2) The *curriculum vitae of* the candidate must include:
 - a) information on studies and diplomas obtained;
 - b) information about professional experience and relevant previous jobs;
- c) information on the R&D projects that he/she has led as project director and the grants obtained, if any, indicating for each source of funding, the volume of funding and the main publications or patents resulting;
 - d) information about awards or other recognition of the candidate's scientific contributions.
- (3) The documents referred to in para. (1) shall be submitted in both written and electronic format, except for scientific papers which shall be submitted only electronically.
- (4) Entries that are not available in electronic format must be submitted in letter format, accompanied by a declaration by the candidate, as per *Annex* 8, that the entries are available in letter format only, and will be collected at the end of the competition.

- (5) Clarifications on the preparation of the letter file and the electronic file:
 - **a.** All the documents in your application file in letter format must be dated with the date of application and signed.
 - b. Each application file will contain an electronic support which is organized as follows:
 - FOLDER 1- Documents to display Name and Surname, containing:
 - 1. Curriculum vitae;
 - 2. Verification sheet for the fulfillment of the standards;
 - 3. Full list of works.

Documents 1.-3. FOLDER 1 shall be drawn up and uploaded on the electronic Word PDF file without signature.

- FOLDER 2- Application file Name and Surname, containing:
 - a. Opis dossier, with the documents organized according to point 8 paragraph (1) letters a)-r) (of the notice).
 - b. Application file, the documents mentioned in point 8(1)(a)-(r) (from the advertisement), scanned (file document dated and signed);
- FOLDER 3- Works-Name and Surname, containing:
- 1. Opis works
- 2. Candidate's papers in the order in the opist
- 5. Detailed information concerning: the description of the research posts advertised, the activities related to each post, the minimum salary of the post at the time of recruitment, the subjects of the competition tests, the description of the competition procedure are detailed in Annex Job description information to this notice, published on www.uaic.ro in the 'Angajari' section.
- 6. The selection board will be set up in accordance with the Decision to be published on: www.uaic.ro, 'Angajari' section.
- 7. Registration for the competition starts on 20.02.2025 and will close on 21.03.2025.
