

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE FOR NON-EU CITIZENS

In accordance with the 2024 Methodology on the admission of non-EU citizens to full degree tuition fee self-paying studies, all applications for admission to study at Alexandru Ioan Cuza University of Iași have to comply with the following:

- Complete files are to be submitted to the International Relations Office within the required deadlines;
- The processing fee of **100 Euros** will be transferred to the bank account below:

Please mention the candidate's full name (as mentioned in the passport) as well as the text "taxă de procesare dosar" (file processing fee).

NOTE: The file processing fee is not refundable.

- The eligibility check of the files will be performed by the International Relations Office; candidates are advised to provide their full contact data (email address, phone, mailing address);
- The Commission of Admissions of each Faculty will then assess and accept/reject the applications;
- For the accepted candidates, the International Relations Office will request the Letter of Acceptance from the Ministry of Education and Research;
- Upon receiving the Letter of Acceptance, admitted students have to pay the tuition fees in order to get the study visa from the Romanian Embassy in their country; bank details for transferring the tuition fees will be communicated by the admission officer.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

A) Admission to studies in Romanian:

- Attending a full-degree programme in Romanian is conditioned by providing a recognized **Romanian** Language Certificate which may be issued by:
- a) one of the Romanian universities accredited to offer the *Preparatory Year of Romanian as a foreign language*;
- b) the Romanian Language Institute or the Romanian Cultural Institute
- Candidates who can prove that **they have attended at least 4 years of study in Romanian** do not need such a certificate.
- If a candidate does not speak Romanian, he/she must attend the courses of the **Preparatory Year (2 semesters)**. During the first semester, international students will study Romanian language for the levels A1-A2. In the second semester, they will continue studying Romanian at an advanced level, focusing on the vocabulary specific to the subject areas chosen by the candidate (Medicine, Sciences, Economy, Law, Humanities). The purpose of the specialized language acquisition module is that of reaching levels B1-B2 by the end of the Preparatory Year.

Should candidates wish to study in a foreign language, they can choose from a list of degrees at Bachelor or Master level that are taught in English, French etc. (please refer to the English version of the university website https://www.uaic.ro/en/studies/degrees-on-offer-in-english-and-french/).

B) Admission to studies in foreign languages:

- Attending a full-degree programme in a foreign language is conditioned by passing a linguistic proficiency exam.
- Candidates' language certificates submitted to their application files are assessed by the Commission of Admissions of the respective Faculty. Students who come from countries with the same official language as the one of their chosen study programme or those who provide an internationally recognized certificate of linguistic proficiency equivalent to CEFR level B2 Upper-Intermediate (e.g. TOEFL, Cambridge, IELTS, DELF B2 or other language certificates as foreseen in the Order no. 5219/2010 issued by the Romanian Ministry of Education, Research, Youth and Sports) do not need to take the linguistic proficiency exam.
- Candidates who include in their application files a language certificate that is not internationally recognized are admitted on condition that they pass the linguistic proficiency exam before the start of the academic year.

UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES: BACHELOR (3 years) / THE PREPARATORY YEAR OF ROMANIAN LANGUAGE FOLLOWED BY BACHELOR STUDIES

Documents required:

- 1. The proof of payment of the file processing fee of 100 Euros, with the mention of the candidate's full name (as specified in the passport);
- 2. One application form duly filled in, with photo;
- 3. Copy of the document certifying the permanent residence in the home country;
- 4. High School Graduation Diploma (Baccalaureate) and the Academic Transcript for the high school studies **certified copies***
- 5. Certificate attesting promotion of the Baccalaureate Exam for graduates of the current calendar year certified copy;
- 6. Birth certificate certified copy;
- 7. Valid passport copy;
- 8. Medical certificate (in an international language) to prove that the candidate does not suffer from infectious diseases or other illnesses that are incompatible with the future profession;
- 9. the parents' or the guardian's consent regarding the stay for study purposes on the territory of Romania, if the applicant is underage
- 10. Language certificate.
- *certified copies of documents in Romanian/English/French, respectively certified authorized translations in English of documents in other languages

Students who apply for recognition of partial studies, in view of continuing their education started in other countries, have to annex certified authorized translation copies of academic transcripts for the completed study years and the corresponding curricula and syllabi.

POSTGRADUATE STUDIES: MASTER (2 years) / THE PREPARATORY YEAR OF ROMANIAN LANGUAGE FOLLOWED BY MASTER STUDIES

Documents required:

- 1. The proof of payment of the file processing fee of 100 Euros, with the mention of the candidate's full name (as specified in the passport);
- 2. One application form duly filled in, with photo;
- 3. Copy of the document certifying the permanent residence in the home country;
- 4. High School Graduation Diploma (Baccalaureate) and the Academic Transcript for the high school studies certified copies*
- 5. Graduation Diploma for Bachelor studies + Academic Transcript/Diploma Supplement for BA/BSc studies certified copies;
- 6. Birth certificate certified copy;
- 7. Valid passport copy;
- 8. Medical certificate (in an international language) to prove that the candidate does not suffer from infectious diseases or other illnesses that are incompatible with the future profession;
- 9. Language certificate.

POSTGRADUATE STUDIES: DOCTORATE (4 years) / THE PREPARATORY YEAR OF ROMANIAN LANGUAGE FOLLOWED BY DOCTORAL STUDIES

Documents required:

- 1. The proof of payment of the file processing fee of 100 Euros, with the mention of the candidate's full name (as specified in the passport);
- 2. One application form duly filled in, with photo;
- 3. Written consent from a potential doctoral supervisor;
- 4. Copy of the document certifying the permanent residence in the home country;
- 5. High School Graduation Diploma and the Academic Transcript for the high school studies certified copies*;
- 6. Graduation Diploma (University BA/BSc Degree) certified copy;
- 7. Postgraduate Diploma (Master Degree) certified copy;
- 8. Certificate attesting promotion of the Bachelor Graduation Exam for graduates of the current calendar year certified copy;
- 9. Academic Transcripts/Diploma Supplements for completed studies (Baccalaureate, BA/BSc, Master) certified copy;
- 10. Birth Certificate certified copy;
- 11. Marriage Certificate or any other document certifying change of name (if applicable) certified copy;
- 12. Valid passport copy;
- 13. Medical certificate (in an international language) to prove that the candidate does not suffer from infectious diseases or other illnesses that are incompatible with the future profession;
- 14. Language Certificate;
- 15. Curriculum vitae;
- 16. List of published scientific papers.

In order to be accepted to studies, candidates for a doctoral degree have to pass the examination organized according to the calendar of each doctoral school. In order to prepare for it, they must keep in touch with the potential doctoral supervisors who agreed to give them a written consent.

- > Preparatory Year of Romanian language, Bachelor and Master candidates: 1st March 15th June
- ➤ PhD candidates have to pass the entrance examination and need to obtain the Letter of Acceptance to studies from the Romanian Ministry of Education and Research (MER) before the date set for the entrance examination by the Doctoral School.

Files submitted at a later date will not be processed.

Accepted candidates are requested to confirm their registration for full-degree studies within 10 days from the receipt by email of the Letter of Acceptance to studies, by paying the entire amount of the tuition fee corresponding for one academic year, in advance.

For enrolment they will present the passport with a Romanian visa for studies and the original documents (from the application file), endorsed with the Hague Apostille.

If the previous studies were completed in countries which are not signatory of the Hague Convention, the original documents must be certified for authentication by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the issuing country and the Embassy of Romania to the issuer country.
